Checklist

Admission to the ward

Inform the nursing staff about

- Diets that you follow (e. g. diabetes diet, low salt)

- Dietary habits (e. g. vegetarian, no pork)

- Incompatibilities (e. g. gluten, lactose)

- Allergies (e. g. to medication, foods, materials)

- Sleeping habits (e. g. rest periods)

Inquire about the fixed appointments during your stay

- Ward rounds

- Operation/examination appointments

- Therapy times

- Meal times

Initial examination by the doctor

Please inform the doctor about

All medications that you are taking (medication plan)

Allergies (e. g. to medication, foods, materials)

Special features (e. g. prostheses, pacemakers, implants)

Sensitivity to pain (especially in the event of planned operations)

Any substance abuse (e. g. tobacco, alcohol, drugs)

Existing living will

For new prescriptions during the entry examination (e. g. examination, medication)

Reason for the new prescription?

Expected result?

Benefits, risks and side effects?

What happens if you refuse the prescription?

Can a generic medicinal product be prescribed instead of an original medicine?
